THE PROJECT

The AN EYE FOR AN EYE (AEFAE) project makes it possible for children from different cultures, not speaking the same language and not able to meet, to communicate through the universal language of photography.

When exchanging their life-stories through images, children re-discover their own environment. They also open themselves up to cultures different from their own.

The role of our association is to set up photo correspondences between groups of children from different countries. We collaborate with local structures that children attend regularly.

Once trained by AEFAE, facilitators at these structures are then able to oversee the exchange in the long term.

What we offer is a ready-made project at minimal cost to our partner structures. In fact, the AEFAE team provides its services for free, supplies the cameras (Powershot D20's) and makes use of recycled materials or basic supplies (paper, pens, etc.).

We work on-site, training one or more people who will then be able to carry out the project over the course of the year. We also provide reference material.

In addition, we coordinate and provide remote assistance for the entire length of the exchange.

BECOME A PARTNER

WHY?

CULTURAL ENRICHMENT – Learn and impart to children the techniques and language of photography, establish communication between groups from different cultures and become enriched through this mutually-beneficial exchange.

INCREASED EXPOSURE – Promote your structure through: exhibitions of children's photography, AEFAE's communication tools (newsletters, website, Facebook page), and the endorsement of professional photographers.

INTERNATIONAL NETWORK – Join the AEFAE network that continues to expand and develop around the world, bringing together photographers, cultural advocates and proponents of international solidarity.

PREREQUISITES

■ Be a structure (association, NGO, community centre, group home, etc.) that acts on behalf of children, within a given territory, on a regular basis and over the whole year.

■ Work with children who are struggling (socially, emotionally or financially).

■ Have the ability to bring together approximately 12 children, aged 8 to 12 years, for a week-long photography training course, and then to regularly provide weekly workshops over the long-term.

■ Have ready access to the Internet.

■ Make available an instructor who will:

- be trained in the AEFAE techniques (1 day),
- teach a week-long photography course in conjunction with the AEFAE team (5 days),
- lead weekly workshops (8h/month) throughout the year,
- ensure coordination (2h/month) with a partner country.

■ If necessary, make available a translator to translate from French to the language spoken by the kids.

■ Have the logistical structures necessary for the proper functioning of the cameras (safe-keeping and electricity).
